It's an exciting time for the Trinity River Vision. Bridge construction is well underway, dirt is moving and property acquisition is nearly complete. All this hard work is making way for a vibrant urban waterfront district in the heart of our city with 12 miles of developable waterfront much like San Antonio's beloved riverwalk. Our project will not only provide great opportunities today, but for generations

to come. Independent research estimates that construction and anticipated development will generate an estimated \$7.9 billion in regional and national economic activity. Once complete, the businesses that will occupy Panther Island are estimated to employ more than 29,600 full time workers and contribute over \$3.7 billion in annual economic activity to the regional economy.

My sincere gratitude goes out to all of our vendors for their hard work on a vision that means so much to our city. 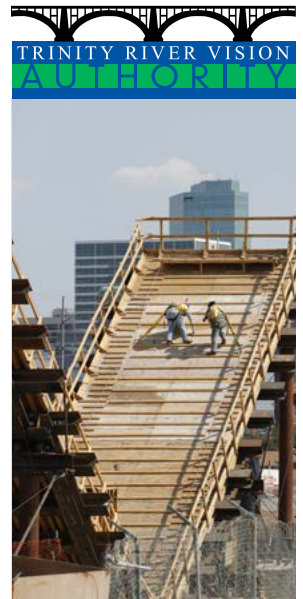

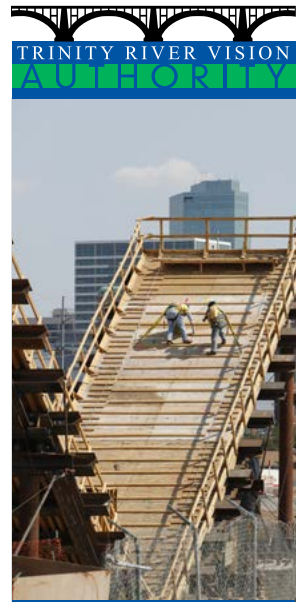
