The call of the roll disclosed the presence of the Directors as follows:

I. Call to Order

President Maenius convened the meeting at 2:05 P.M. with the assurance that a quorum was present and all requirements of the Texas Open Meetings Act had been met.

II. Public Comment

Ms. Stella Brooks voiced comments concerning the effects of gas boats operating in the Trinity River and the importance of background checks when hiring contractors.

III. Action Items

A1.

On a motion made by Director Brooks and seconded by Director Henderson, the Directors unanimously voted to approve the minutes from the meeting held on May 2, 2012. Director Higgins was not present for the vote.

With the recommendation of Sandy Newby (Chief Financial Officer, TRVA), Director Henderson made a motion to receive and file the TRVA Finance Report. The motion was seconded by Director Brooks and the vote in favor was unanimous. Director Higgins was not present for the vote.

A3.

With the recommendation of Ms. Newby, Director Oliver made a motion to receive and file the Central City Finance Report. The motion was seconded by Director Henderson and the vote in favor was unanimous. President Maenius noted that the Tarrant County Commissioners Court approved a 1.5 million dollar transfer to the City of Fort Worth for the Central City Project. To date, Tarrant County has contributed 6.5 million.

A4.

With the recommendation of JD Granger (Executive Director, TRVA), Director Brooks made a motion to recommend to the Tarrant Regional Water District that it accept a contribution from Coors Distributing of Fort Worth for the commissioning of the Major Ripley Allen Arnold statue to be placed in the John V. McMillan Park for a tentative opening date of June 6, 2013. The motion was seconded by Director Henderson and the vote in favor was unanimous.

A5.

With the recommendation of Woody Frossard (Project Manager, TRVA), Director Oliver made a motion to approve the award of a contract for White Settlement Street Bridge Final Design to Freese and Nichols, Inc. The motion was seconded by Director Brooks and the vote in favor was unanimous.

IV. Discussion Items

Trinity River Vision Update - Six Month Review and Six Month Outlook

TRV Project Managers Woody Frossard, Mark Rauscher, Shanna Cate, Rachel Navejar, and JD Granger (Executive Director) provided a detailed presentation that reviewed project accomplishments over the last six months and provided an outlook on what actions are coming up in the next six months. Primary topics included land acquisition, business relocation, demolition, Trinity Uptown bridges, utility relocation, environmental cleanup, Gateway Park, development, public outreach, events, neighborhood and recreational enhancement projects, and other project updates.
