

TRVA FAIR CONTRACTING COMMITTEE TOURS TRINITY RIVER VISION PROJECT AREAS



The TRVA Fair Contracting Committee and Guests

On Monday, April 20, members of the Trinity River Vision Authority Fair Contracting Committee had the opportunity to take a bus tour of several important pieces of the Trinity River Vision Project.

This committee includes representatives from city government, chambers of commerce, project sponsors, and various other agencies. The FCC has grown from 18 members in 2006 to 28 members to date. The committees' efforts not only focus on disadvantage business inclusion, but also on educating local contractors of all sizes to keep the dollars and work local. The motto continues to be "opportunity for all."

TRVA Executive Director, J.D. Granger, thanked the committee for their work and informed every one of the progress that has been made to the TRV Project and the commitment to working and providing DB opportunities to our communities.

Once on the tour, the first stop on was a look at the progress of Panther Island Bridge construction as well as the progress made on the roundabout located at the intersection of Henderson Street and White Settlement which is associated with the bridge construction. The FCC group had the opportunity to step off the bus and take a closer look at the construction site while Scott Cooner and Chuck Wier of TxDOT gave a great overview of the current construction

progress. Thank you to Scott and Chuck for taking the time to give the committee an overview of the bridge work and roundabouts.

From there, the tour continued up North Main Street and featured an update on current and future environmental remediation and demolition work necessary for the Panther Island Project.

The tour's last two locations were Gateway and Riverside Park. At Gateway Park, soil removal is currently underway thanks to the U.S. Army Corps of Engineers and the City of Fort Worth. While visiting Riverside Park, the committee learned about the flood risk management basis that will go to bid this summer. Both of these locations are being prepped for future recreational opportunities. A few of the improvements include: trail improvements, picnic pavilions, observation decks and many others. PROGRESS COMING TO GATEWAY AND RIVERSIDE PARK

Thanks to \$17.4 million awarded to the Trinity River Vision project from the U.S. Army Corps of Engineers necessary flood risk management basins in Gateway Park West and Riverside Park will be underway soon. Scheduled to begin this summer, this work is connected to the development of

the Panther Island Project which includes a new Trinity River promenade, flood risk management infrastructure and the redevelopment of Gateway Park. In addition, thanks to a \$5 million grant secured by the City of Fort Worth, improvements are also coming to Gateway Park East.

As part of the Panther Island Project, crews have worked hard for the past two years to clean up the area to make way for construction. We have hauled out over 15,000 dump truck loads worth of contaminated material adjacent to our river and water supply. That's enough to fill up nearly half of Cowboys Stadium in Arlington! These environmental sites are now up to residential standards.
